

#### About the S2AY Rural Health Network:

The S2AY Rural Health Network is comprised of the Public Health Departments in seven (7) rural counties (Schuyler, Seneca, Steuben, Allegany, Ontario, Wayne and Yates), along with a legislator, consumer and provider from each county. The Network has been in existence since 1997, expanding from the original three counties (Steuben, Allegany and Yates) to add Schuyler in 1998, and Seneca, Ontario, and Wayne first in June 2002, and officially in January 2003. An additional six (6) counties (Chemung, Cortland, Livingston, Monroe, Tompkins and Tioga) are also served by some Network projects. The mission of the Network is: *To integrate, promote and expand appropriate components of the Public Health service delivery system to improve health outcomes for all residents of the Network region.*

## FUNDS AVAILABLE FOR BREAST CANCER RELATED EXPENSES

The S2AY Rural Health Network has funds available from the Susan G. Komen for the Cure Foundation for breast cancer related expenses.

Working through the Cancer Services Partnership (CSP) of Ontario, Seneca and Yates Counties, these funds are targeted for uninsured and under-insured individuals for diagnostic and treatment services and expenses related to breast cancer.

Eligible expenses include testing, prosthetics, wigs, and transportation costs (including mileage reimbursement for travel to medical appointments).

### Eligibility requirements:

- ⇒ You have a breast health issue
- ⇒ You live in Ontario, Yates or Seneca County
- ⇒ You are uninsured or under-insured
- ⇒ Your family income is less than 200% of the Federal Poverty Level per the chart below, OR
- ⇒ You have extreme financial hardship
